1. Outline Tokyo Tech students are invited to participate in the Student Workshop, a student exchange program organized in conjunction with the annual ASPIRE Forum. Participants will attend lectures and participate in site visits on the theme "Smart Cities." In teams comprised of student counterparts from ASPIRE League and IDEA League member universities, participants will develop group presentations related to the workshop theme and deliver them to the ASPIRE League's Vice Presidents on the final day of the ASPIRE Forum.

 - Graduate students at Tokyo Institute of Technology
 - English language speaking ability is required for participants to engage in discussions.

Students are responsible for their own travel insurance, airfare, and personal expenses. (A stipend to cover some expenses may be provided by Tokyo Tech. In the case of international students, only privately-funded, degree-seeking students are eligible to receive the stipend.)
