In 2018, as part of the Consortium's activities, Tokyo Tech will host a Winter Program to provide students with the opportunity to participate in a longer-term lab-based research project.

Program Overviews

Winter Program (November 29, 2018 – February 8, 2019)

Students will undertake an independent research project in a laboratory under the supervision of a Tokyo Tech faculty member. Tokyo Tech will issue a certificate to students who successfully complete the program.

*Note: Participants are recommended to stay for the full period.

Number of participants

In principle, three (3) students from each university will be admitted.

Program Expenses

Tuition, fees and stipend

University tuition and related fees for this program will be waived. Highly qualified students will receive a stipend of 80,000 JPY/month through a scholarship from the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT).

Accommodation

Tokyo Tech will provide participants with off-campus accommodation at no charge.

Program Eligibility Requirements

Home university

Students must be enrolled at Tsinghua University or Korea Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (KAIST) and nominated for the program by their home university

Year of study

Undergraduate 4th year students and graduate students at the time of participation.
