





Under the CAMPUS Asia Initiative of the governments of Japan, China and South Korea, Tokyo Tech is an active participant in and contributor to the TKT CAMPUS Asia Consortium, a joint education and research program with Tsinghua University and KAIST. In summer 2020, as part of the Consortium's activities, Tokyo Tech offers a CAMPUS Asia Summer School Research-oriented Program. Tokyo Tech will also host a Joint Educational Program (JEP) to provide students with the opportunity to participate in a longer-term labbased research project while taking some courses.

CAMPUS Asia Program Tracks and Scheduling

There are three different CAMPUS Asia programs or tracks:

- **A) Summer School < Research-Oriented Program>** *No Course-Oriented Program will be held in 2020. June 22, 2020 August 7, 2020 (7 weeks)
- B) Joint Educational Program (JEP) Late September, 2020 – Early February, 2021
- C) Summer School < Research-Oriented Program> + Joint Educational Program (JEP)
 June 22, 2020 Early February, 2021



Program Overviews

A) Summer School <Research-Oriented Program> June 22, 2020 - August 7, 2020 (7 weeks)

Participants will conduct research projects in Tokyo Tech labs under the guidance of faculty members. The program also offers Japanese language course for beginners, field trip to Kamakura with local students to get to know each other, and 21st Century Skills Seminars during the program. A certificate will be issued after successfully completing the program. Please refer to the Program Calendar for more details.

B) Joint Educational Program (JEP) Late September, 2020 – Early February, 2021

Students will undertake an independent research project in a laboratory under the supervision of a Tokyo Tech faculty member. Those who plan to be at Tokyo Tech for the entire second semester (September 2020 - February 2021) are encouraged to register for courses as well. Tokyo Tech will issue a certificate to students who successfully complete the program. To facilitate the recognition of credits at students' home universities, Tokyo Tech will also issue an official academic record to those who have taken courses.

C) Summer School <Research-Oriented Program>+ Joint Educational Program (JEP) June 22, 2020 - Early February, 2021

*Note: <u>Participants in the Summer School are required to stay for the full period.</u> As for the other programs, the period of stay varies based on each student's research plans and their home university's academic calendar, however, the participants are strongly recommended to stay for the full period.

Number of participants

In principle, five (5) students in total from each university (Tsinghua and KAIST) will be admitted.

Program Expenses

Tuition, fees and stipend

University tuition and related fees for this program will be waived. Highly qualified students will receive a stipend of 80,000 JPY/month through a scholarship from the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT).

Accommodation

Tokyo Tech will provide participants with off-campus accommodation (shared house) at no charge.

Program Eligibility Requirements

Home university

Students must be enrolled at Tsinghua University or Korea Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (KAIST) and nominated for the program by their home university.

Year of study

Undergraduate students who have completed at least their third year at the time of participation. Graduate students at the time of participation.

GPA and English Test Score

A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.3 on a 3.0 scale, and at least a score of 70 on the TOEFL iBT / 650 on the TOEIC exam / 5.5 on the IELTS Overall Band.
