Overview

Tsinghua (China), KAIST (Korea), and Tokyo Tech (Japan) formed the "TKT CAMPUS Asia Consortium" in 2011 and have worked together to promote education and research collaboration as well as faculty and student exchanges through CAMPUS Asia Project Modes 1 and 2. In Mode 3, started in 2021, NTU (Singapore) joined the consortium as a partner university, aiming to further enhance the program.

As part of the Consortium's activities, in the summer of 2022, Tokyo Tech will hold a summer school online in consideration of preventing the spread of COVID-19. The purpose of this summer school is to provide undergraduate and graduate students who wish to study at Tokyo Tech in the near future with an opportunity to learn about the Japanese language and Tokyo Tech, as well as to work in teams with students from the four CAMPUS Asia Plus universities.
