1. About TKT CAMPUS Asia

Based on Trilateral Cooperation Vision 2020 that was adopted between the governments of China, Japan and Korea, the TKT CAMPUS Asia Consortium was established in 2011 among the following universities: Tsinghua University (China), KAIST (South Korea), and the Tokyo Institute of Technology (Japan).

2. Symposium Overview

TKT CAMPUS Asia Research Symposium, which will be held for 2 days in December 4th (Friday) to 5th (Saturday), mainly consists of student presentations. Unlike other symposiums, this one is open to any students in science and engineering fields. Students will have a chance to learn from each other about a broad range of research topics. In addition, they will have an opportunity to practice research presentation to the general public and improve communication and presentation skills. This symposium will mostly run by students. Sessions will be moderated by student chairs and presentations will be evaluated by participating students.

3. Student Presentation

- Duration of the presentation is 20 minutes including Q&A
- Presentation should be about your research and has to be demonstrated in a way that a general audience can easily understand
- Depending on the number of applicants, some of presentations can be changed to poster presentations

4. Abstract Guidelines

- Research can be complete or in progress
- Abstracts should include background, methods, results (or statement of expected results for incomplete work), and conclusion
- Photos related to research can be included
- Please use the abstract template provided

5. Benefits of Participation

- A certificate of participation will be issued
- Top 5 presentations will receive a prize with award certificate! And much more prizes are prepared such as best chair awards, 5 best audience awards, best abstract awards, and more. Various prizes (ex. 4TB portable hard drive and many more) will be given.
- Participants' abstracts will be published into a booklet

6. Eligibility

- Chinese, Japanese and Korean national students enrolled at Tsinghua University, Tokyo Institute of Technology, and KAIST
- Interested in TKT CAMPUS Asia program
- Reasonable command of the English Language
- Priority will be given to Master/PhD Students
