Program Overview

Tsinghua University (China), Tokyo Institute of Technology (Japan), KAIST (South Korea), and Nanyang Technological University (Singapore) jointly offer their first virtual camp "T²KN CAMPUS Asia Plus Online Winter Camp" to students of the four universities. This three-day intensive winter camp mainly consists of special lectures of the faculty members of the four universities and team projects. Through this online winter camp, students will meet new friends from the four nations and work together as teams, thereby gaining an opportunity to expand their networks both professionally and personally.

Participating students will:

- Have an opportunity to listen to special lectures by professors of the four universities
- Improve team discussion, presentation and communication skills
- Get to know other students from four nations
- Deepen the understanding of cultures of other countries
- Feel a sense of accomplishment at the end of the camp
